An exceptional pair of gilded and lacquered consoles, each with "Breccia Medicea" marble top from Vitulano quarries, Naples, late 18th century (140 cm wide, 89 cm high, 64 cm deep) (55 in. wide, 35 in. high, 25 in. deep). Attribution to Gennaro di Fiore, a famous Neapolitan cabinetmaker. Bibliography : Il Mobile Neoclassico in Italia, Enrico Colle, Ed. Electa, page 84, similar consoles are in the Deputy Chamber. "Guide du Palais de Caserta", Ed. Skira, page 38, a pair of similar consoles are located at the Royal Palace of Caserta (near Naples) in the Autumn room (18th century apartments),
